Background

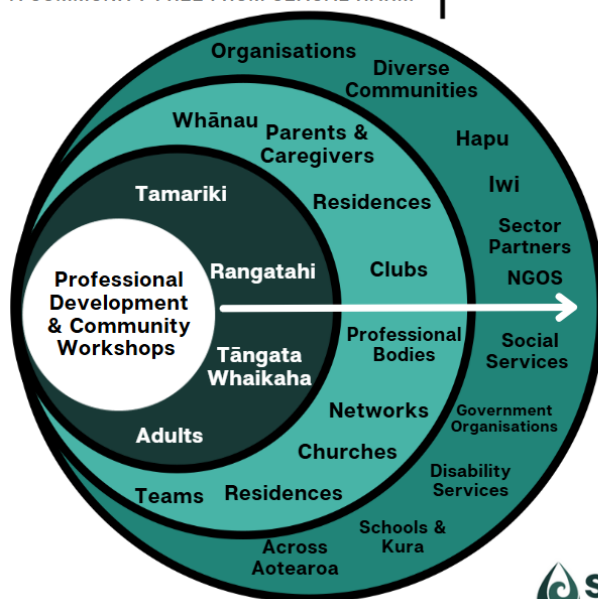
Stop is a not-for-profit organisation that specialises in responding to Concerning Sexual Behaviour (CSB) by tamariki (children) and Harmful Sexual Behaviour (HSB) by rangatahi (adolescents) and pakeke (adults). For over 30 years Stop has delivered high quality therapeutic and clinical services to individuals, whānau, communities, government organisations and tertiary institutions across Te Waipounamu.

Stop has built and maintained a strong reputation in the sexual harm sector. Our prevention focus continues as we support and equip whānau, schools, organisations and communities. Our work is underpinned by our vision “He hāpori wātea taitōkai – A community free from sexual harm”. We recognise that for our vision to be realized, we must take action in meaningful ways through prevention education and training to strengthen the wider community’s ability to respond well to sexual harm.

Stop has extensive experience facilitating professional development workshops and education sessions to support community professionals, whānau, educators and organisations to recognise HSB and CSB, when to seek support from specialist services (like Stop) and to increase the skills and confidence of responsible adults in responding effectively to CSB and HSB concerns, tailored to their circumstances and context.

Our Impact



Why is Prevention & Community Education Important?

Harmful sexual behaviour is pervasive across all communities. We believe the solutions lie within our community to shift a culture that minimises harm. Therefore, we look to complement knowledge from within different communities in our work to address CSB, and prevent HSB, through increasing the skills, confidence and knowledge of professionals, communities and whānau. The hope is we enable communities/adults to collaboratively combat the complex social issue of sexual harm.

Our workshops are facilitated by compassionate and highly skilled Prevention and Clinical kaimahi (staff), who have extensive experience in working alongside our diverse clients, with whānau and communities.

Our Services

We provide engaging, informative and compelling workshops, these are tailored to cater to diverse groups e.g. faith-based communities, schools, youth workers, specific organisations and parents/whānau. These can vary in duration and subject matter depending on need e.g. relating to a specific developmental age group, role of the participants and their knowledge of CSB/HSB.

Our workshops could have a specific focus or a general overview. For example, tamariki (children), rangatahi (adolescents), orientation to www.presspause.org.nz, pakeke (adults), neurodiversity and inclusion focused, residential care focused, for parents & whānau, faith-based communities etc.

Please note: For workshops with a specific focus there is potential for additional preparation time to be required to ensure this is tailored to the needs of the participant group for the greatest impact. This is discussed and worked through during the engagement and consultation process.

Workshops and presentations are usually scheduled several months in advance; availability will depend on our team's calendar. We are happy to travel to provide education and training services across Te Waipounamu and in some instances across wider Aotearoa, travel costs and expenses can be discussed for individual requests.

Our Funding Model

To ensure the continued delivery of the high-quality services offered by our team, we have reviewed and implemented a new funding model to take effect from October 2025. We define this model as 'Pricing for Purpose', it acknowledges that organisations, businesses, kura/schools, communities and charities have different means available to them to invest in Professional Development.

The model enables us to define appropriate pricing tiers/ across agencies to ensure our services remain as accessible as possible for all. We can consider individual circumstances around workshop costs, as our priority and vision are to support the community in reducing sexual harm. Please contact us to discuss your situation.

The cost of your workshop will depend on your event requirements, the duration and your organisation/event/ professional development type. Venues can vary depending on the size of the group and availability. It is anticipated that should a venue or catering be required the party commissioning Stop's services would be responsible for organising the venue and the associated costs of venue hire and catering (if required). Should travel and accommodation be required from our team, this can be further discussed when planning the training.
